Packaging Guide for Air and Express Shipments

Simple packaging principles that help protect goods through collection, sorting, air transport and final delivery.

Choose the right outer packaging

- ☐ Use a rigid, undamaged carton appropriate for the contents and weight.
- ☐ Avoid reused cartons that have lost strength or retain old labels.
- ☐ Use a suitable pallet or crate for heavy, oversized or vulnerable cargo.

Protect the contents

- ☐ Wrap items individually and prevent direct contact between products.
- ☐ Fill empty space so the contents cannot move inside the package.
- ☐ Protect sharp edges, fragile surfaces and protruding parts.
- ☐ Keep liquids upright in leak-resistant inner and outer packaging.

Seal, label and measure

- ☐ Use strong pressure-sensitive packing tape across all seams.
- ☐ Place the transport label on the largest flat surface.
- ☐ Record final packed dimensions and weight - not product dimensions.
- ☐ Do not band multiple loose cartons together unless the service permits it.

Special goods

Dangerous, temperature-sensitive, high-value and regulated products require additional controls. Speak with ISE Logistics before packing or booking.
